

Three Rivers Rowing Association Private Coaching Policy

This policy applies to all paid coached sessions of whatever nature on the TRRA premises outside of a regularly scheduled team practice.

All Coaches

All private coaches are required to apply to TRRA staff for approval to provide the sessions offered. Private coaches must be authorized to use TRRA facilities and equipment, including rowing shells, launches, ergs, tanks, weight room, etc, and must reserve same with TRRA staff. Any coach giving a lesson must continue to ensure that a TRRA waiver is signed and a TRRA swim test is completed. Both should be turned into the TRRA office.

Coaches using TRRA equipment for the sessions

Any coached session using TRRA boats and/or TRRA launches will incur a facility and usage fee. This fee will be a minimum of 30% of the fee charged to the individual or group receiving the coaching unless other arrangements are made with the TRRA ED.

Equipment Reservation

Regularly scheduled team practices and TRRA programs have priority for equipment and facility usage. For rowing lessons using TRRA equipment, coaches must either reserve a boat (through the online system) for prospective members, or assure TRRA members have properly reserved a boat. For lessons that require a TRRA launch, it must be reserved with TRRA office staff.

Payment

Payment can be made through the TRRA website, at the TRRA office or to the coach. TRRA will remit to the coach the portion of the fee payable to the coach on a bi-weekly basis if the fee is paid to TRRA. If the fee is given directly to the coach, they must remit the agreed-upon fee to TRRA within 10 days of the coaching session, unless other arrangements are made.
